



2024 Escort Officer Supplemental

As an IACE Escort Officer, you would be supervising the Civil Air Patrol cadets participating in IACE in your host country. It's an important role, so to help the selection process, respond to the following prompts.

Each response must be no longer than 100 words. 1) If you are a former cadet, describe your cadet experience and highest cadet grade. If not, use your involvement in JROTC, Scouting, etc.	
2) Have you participated in a National Cadet Special activity? If so, identify where and when, whether you were a participant, staff member and briefly describe you duties. If not, have you participated in an encampment or other week-long cadet programs event?	
3) Describe your CAP leadership experience above the squadron level. If you have none, describe the leadership experience you do have.	





4) Describe your experience(s) in the cadet program as a senior member.	
5) What are the best and worst decisions that you have ever made as it related to leadership of cadets? What did you learn from each example?	
6) How would you react if your decisions are challenged by a cadet?	





7) How would you react if your decisions are challenged by another adult?	
8) Describe your community service involvement outside of CAP. Examples might include civic clubs, church groups, Boy or Girl Scouts, or other volunteer groups.	
9) How have these experiences helped to make you a better leader for the CAP Cadet Program?	





10) What medical certifications do you have? Examples might include CPR, First Aid, etc.
11) What aviation ratings do you have? Such as CAP Mission Scanner, power/glider solo, power/glider pilot certificate, etc.
12) Have you traveled internationally as an adult? If so, which countries, when and why?





13) Describe your familiarity with a foreign language. If you do not know a foreigr language, explain why it might be advantages to understand another language.	
14) Have you ever been on IACE? If so, where and when? Did you go as a cadet or senior? What did you get out of the experience?	
15) Have you assisted with a local IACE hosting event?	





16) Why do you want to be an IACE Escort Officer?	
17) What special aspects of your education or training have prepared you to be a representative escort of cadets in this exchange?	
18) List the three countries you chose as your preferences. With each country, describe why you want to visit that country.	





19) Explain the purpose of IACE and its parent organization, the International Air Cadet Exchange Association.	
20) Describe the three most important duties of an Escort.	
21) You and your cadets are at an official reception and dinner given by the provincial governor of your host country. Wine and beer have been made available by the wait staff to all participants, and you are told that wine is provided at each setting. How do you approach this situation?	





22) Your cadets are asked by cadets from another country in your group to go out with them for "a walk" after dinner. How do you approach this situation?	
23) When you are in your host country and a tourist not associated with your group makes a rude comment about the United States, what do you do?	
24) When is the IACE travel uniform required to be worn?	





25) What steps would you take if one of your cadets have misplaced/lost their passport?	
26) What steps would you take if your flight home from your host country is cancelled?	
27) It is the day before Sabbath and one of your cadets wishes to worship. The schedule does not have any time for religious services scheduled. How do you approach this situation?
