



Lieutenant Colonel Jacqueline A. Fleming is the Director, Reserve Forces Headquarters, Civil Air Patrol-USAFA, Maxwell AFB, AL. She is the principal advisor to the CAP-USAFA Commander for nationwide operations involving USAFA reservists, and oversees all reservist hiring and training. Additionally, she develops, coordinates, and executes operations evaluations across all eight regions to ensure the Civil Air Patrol is trained and equipped to perform three congressionally assigned missions – emergency services, aerospace education for youth and the general public, and cadet programs for teenage youth.

Lt Col Fleming graduated from Purdue University and was commissioned in 2002 from Officer Training School. She earned her wings at Vance AFB, Oklahoma. As a C-141 and C-5 pilot in the 89th Airlift Squadron, Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio, she flew medical evacuation flights in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and later strategic transport missions in Operation Enduring Freedom. She was a Captain in the Limited Brands Flight Operations, conducting domestic and international executive transport for the \$12B annual revenue corporation. Currently, she is a United Airlines First Officer and is qualified in the Boeing 757, 767, and 777.

Lt Col Fleming holds 7 type ratings in a variety of military and civilian aircraft, and has over 8,000 flying hours.
